The successful applicant will join a multidisciplinary research group working on natural resources and global change. Research should be focus on basic ecological process of watershed management and ecological modelling and interact with other disciplines to solve water-vegetation-soil problems.

Qualifications: Ph.D. in a relevant field. Excellent oral and written communication skills. Experience in teaching and a strong knowledge of watershed management and ecological modelling are expected. Teaching responsibilities include courses at the undergraduate and graduate levels. Basic and applied research will be conducted to support watershed management and planning at local and regional levels, and results published in scientific journals. Graduate student advising and cooperative work with other faculties are expected. Applicants should submit a cover letter indicating why they feel they are a good fit for the position at PUC, together with a curriculum vita and three letters of recommendation.
